REMINDERS

DISTANCE LEARNING

The Governor's executive order requires that we continue providing learning as we have been. Please understand that participation in distance learning is <u>not optional</u>.

DIGITAL ACCESS

We are primarily relying on technology and Internet access. We have worked with several families to ensure everyone has access. If you are struggling with access to equipment or Internet, it is imperative that you contact us right away. Please send a DOJO message or email Dr. Lackey at <u>klackey@tipton-academy.org</u>.

TIME ON SCHOOLWORK

There have been many questions about how much time your child should be spending on schoolwork each day. This is new to all of us and as we work on meaningful teaching and learning we want it to be appropriate for all of our children. Here is the guide that we will be using at Tipton.

GSRP: Approximately 60 minutes per day.

<u>*K-2nd Grade:*</u> Approximately 90 minutes per day including all subjects. With an additional 15-30 minutes if needing additional services in MTSS, Special Education, or ELL. <u>*3rd-5th Grade:*</u> Approximately 120 minutes per day including all subjects. With an additional 15-30 minutes if needing additional services in MTSS, Special Education, or ELL. <u>*6th-8th Grade:*</u> Approximately 150 minutes per day with 30 minutes per subject for 5 subjects. With an additional 15-30 minutes if needing additional services in MTSS, Special Education, or ELL.

Please remember, this is our guide for parents and teachers. Some days may be a little more while other days may be a little less, but this information will help all of us to plan our days.

ATTENDANCE/ENGAGEMENT

We will be tracking our students' attendance through their engagement in three areas:

<u>2-Way Communication</u>: We need to ensure that students are in communication with their teachers throughout the week. This can be through DOJO, email, phone, or Google Classroom. If they are responding to requests or asking questions, they will be marked engaged in this area.

<u>Digital Learning Time</u>: This is the amount of time spent on Khan Academy, Moby Max, and/or IXL. Each platform provides a report of the amount of time the students are engaged in learning. If students are participating in their assigned activities, they will be marked engaged in this area.

<u>Live Lessons/Office Hours</u>: These are the Zoom or Google meetings that your student's teachers are hosting twice per week. If your student attends one or more of these meetings, they will be marked engaged in this area.

While it is much more difficult for us to track attendance, if your child is engaged in the learning activities we are providing, they will be marked present for the week. Engagement is not the same as academic grades. Grades will follow our regular grading scale and be based upon student progress toward learning outcomes.
