OVERVIEW OF COMPREHENSIVE PROGRAM ASSESSMENTS:

Tipton has continued to reach toward pre-COVID student performance and made continued growth since 2020 as measured by the NWEA MAP assessments. Tipton utilizes the growth measures from NWEA MAP to drill down and address individual student learning gaps. Additionally, Tipton utilizes the AMIRA running record and diagnostic reading assessment to screen for dyslexia in addition to determining student learning plans, as well as Do the Math weekly skill assessments to determine growth and learning plans in the area of mathematics. Lastly, as part of the comprehensive instructional and assessment program, Tipton uses the HMH Anywhere Core Curriculum module assessment data to determine which standards students have mastered and which need additional instruction. All students participate in supplemental ELA and Math support at tiers designated by their student outcome data.

Professional Development:

All K-5 teaching staff and designated 6th-8th grade staff have received training through Evidenced Based Literacy Instruction supporting the Science of Reading through the EBLI ETSL platform and additionally through in-person coaching during the 23-24 and 24-25 school year. All K-5th grade teaching staff have been trained in and received coaching in implementing Into Reading, Into Math, AMIRA and WAGGLE for core and supplemental instructional support during the 23,24, 25 school years. Additionally, all K-5th grade staff have participated in Do the Math in-person coaching during the 24-25 school year.

Ongoing coaching and professional learning communities supporting the implementation of core curriculum, supplemental, and data analysis happen on a monthly basis with all K-8th grade teaching staff.
